

eVoting Response

The parish-wide poll to determine how to spend the Community Infrastructure Levy received by Moulton Parish Council, closed on Saturday evening. Moulton Parish Council are delighted to report that the turnout was over 24%, as hundreds of votes were cast on our new eVoting platform and in person at our community surgeries.

Result

The number of votes cast was as follows:

All weather footpath from School Lane to Honeyvale Gardens	124
Armistice Bench for VE Day	45
Plant trees adjacent to the MUGA	37
Updated CCTV on Moulton Park	34
Dog waste bins around the village	19
Widen Jack Lane footpath near Purcell Place	16
Lighting on footpath between Niddries Lane and Holst Gardens	5
Secure bicycle stands	0
TOTAL	280

There were 1,161 eligible properties who could cast votes.

Response

The parish council will now work to install an all-weather footpath between School Lane and Honeyvale Gardens, and then, if there are funds remaining, work down the list in order of preference – as expressed by the community.

Moulton Parish Council would like to offer their thanks to all those who took part in voting; the turnout of nearly 1 in 4, far exceeds the Moulton Neighbourhood Plan and the Moulton Parish Poll held last year, and the parish council will be soliciting comments and feedback regarding the eVoting platform that was used for this exercise.
